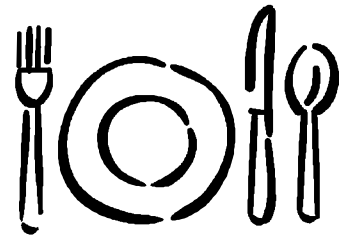


Do you know someone that could benefit from nutritious meals delivered right to their door? AgeWell Services can help through our Meals on Wheels program!



Basic Eligibility for Meals on Wheels

The person must be 60 years of age or older, or the spouse of someone at least 60 years of age and eligible to receive meals.

The person must be homebound: i.e.; does not leave his/her home under normal conditions.

The person must be unable to participate in a congregate nutrition program

The individual must be able to feed him/herself.

Individuals agree to be at home when meals are delivered or contact the program when absence is unavoidable.

All Meals on Wheels clients are assessed within 10 days of beginning our program. Professional staff visit seniors in their homes. Clients are reassessed every 6 months that they remain in the program.

Many Meal Options

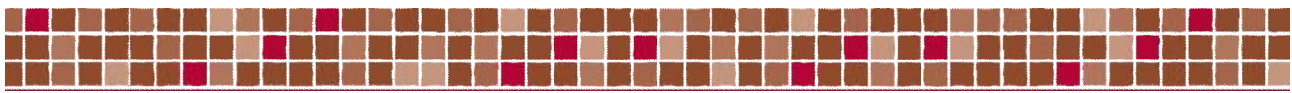

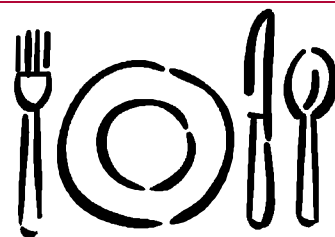

Meals on Wheels

If it appears that someone is eligible to receive Meals on Wheels, using the criteria on the reverse side, a call can be made to AgeWell at 1-800-442-6769 to begin the enrollment process or a visit to our offices at Tanglewood Park, 560 Seminole Road in Muskegon (M-F, 8a-3p).



The information needed to enroll is name, address, phone number, date of birth, emergency contact, types of meals needed and estimated monthly income. The meals are not free and we ask for a “fair share” contribution based on income and work to find an amount they are comfortable with donating for the service. We do accept Bridge Cards—they need to request a voucher from us. The fair share contribution can be done by cash, check or money order. A monthly statement is sent to verify meals received.

For those age 60+ who are able to get out of the house, we offer many different congregate meal sites where not only are nutritious meals served but there are many different social opportunities.
